Thank you for purchasing this Kildwick toilet. These products have been developed for off-grid use in boats, cabins, vans and tourist sites. In the development process a great deal of attention is placed on creating simplicity and improving hygiene through great design and use of materials that are anti-bacterial and/or easy to clean.

Key things you'll notice when you first get your toilet:

- It's not plastic - why?
 - As 'off-grid' people, we like to keep manufacture local and simple - using natural materials wherever possible and using craft skills to create unique products.
 - The off-grid market is not 'mass-volume' so the tooling for plastic components are too expensive. Strengthening pieces in plastic products also provide ideal breeding grounds for bacterial and 'crawlies' - Kildwick toilets don't have these.
- The sides of the base are remarkably thin - how?
 - We have developed a composite process getting the best from the properties of wood and glass-fibre. The top edge presents a slight illusion also making the side seem thinner.
- The sides seem to 'flex' a bit - is this safe?
 - The flexing is a result of our process which creates a very strong, thin but slightly flexible material. The flex is of no concern - just think of the flexibility of the wings of jumbo jets that are still incredibly strong!
- You stain/paint finish isn't 'perfect'?
 - We are working with natural materials and hand-made processes so you will see some natural variation in the finish. This is perfectly normal and make for every product being unique. The Japanese called this approach 'Shibusu' - the appreciation of natural variations in things!
